What Is Open Access??



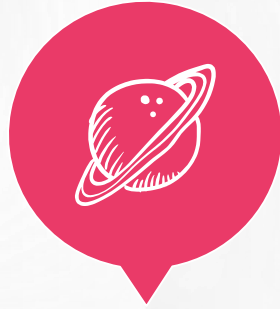
Open Access

- The open access movement began in the 1990s, as access to the internet became widely available and online publishing became the norm.
- OA is free availability on the public internet, permitting any users to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles, crawl them for indexing, pass them as data to software, or use them for any other lawful purpose *without financial, legal, or technical barriers other than those inseparable from gaining access to the internet itself.* (BOAI declaration 2002)
- For a work to be OA, the copyright holder must consent in advance to let users "copy, use, distribute, transmit and display the work publicly and to make and distribute derivative works, in any digital medium for any responsible purpose, subject to proper attribution of authorship(Bethesda and Berlin Declaration)

Open Access

- a set of principles and a range of practices which research outputs are distributed online, free of access charges or other barriers.^[1] following open access 2001 definition(BOAI 2002), or libre open access, barriers to copying or reuse are also reduced or removed by applying an open license for copyright.^[1]





What is OA Journal



Journals that use a funding model that does not charge readers or their institutions for access.



Supporting the rights of users to "read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles"

OA Journal Vs Subscriptions Journal

- ❑ Readers are not charged
- ❑ Authors generally retain copyright (usually Use Open access License mostly use CC License)
- ❑ compatible with copyright, peer-review, revenue (even profit), print,preservation, prestige, quality, career-advancement, indexing, and other features and supportive services associated with conventional scholarly literature.
- ❑ Known As Traditional/ conventional Journal
- ❑ require readers to pay for the content that they read
- ❑ copyrights for the published content are usually transferred to the journal

Type of OA Journals : Colour Naming System

- Gold OA
(provides OA to its peer-reviewed research articles, without delay)
- Green OA
(permits authors to deposit their peer-reviewed manuscripts in OA repositories)
- Hybrid OA
(contain a mixture of open access articles and closed access articles)
- Bronze OA (free to read only on the publisher page)
- Diamond/platinum OA
(publish open access without charging authors article processing)
- Black OA (Unauthorized digital copying by large-scale copyright infringement has enabled free access to paywalled literature)

What is the DOAJ?



- Launched in May 2003, Lund University, Sweden
 - list of 300 titles
- Funded initially by one-off grants – membership and sponsorship model funding started in 2006
- DOAJ Ambassador programme covers all major world regions (with exception of Japan)
- Since 2013 run by Infrastructure Services for Open Access / IS4OA (www.is4oa.org) held in UK as non-for-profit company engaged in the interests and interests of the community
- Centrally, publicly and internationally available community-curated list of > 17,000 high quality open access journal titles across all disciplines (scientific/scholarly) from 130 countries
- Also lists journals publishing in local language only

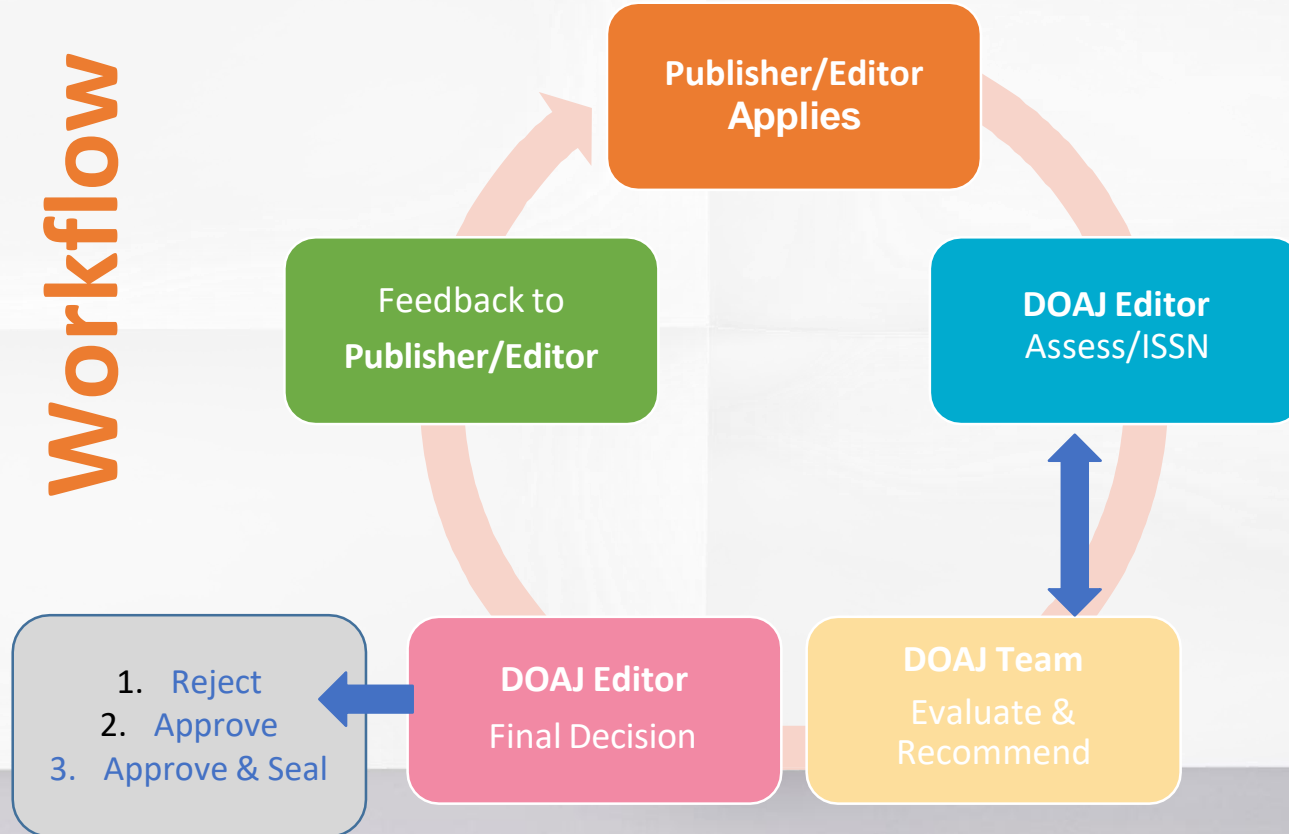

Workflow



THREE-TIER EVALUATION PROCESS



Associate Editors: reviewing applications, communicate with publishers, recommend inclusion/rejection

Editors: allocating applications to Associate Editors, recommend inclusion/rejection

Managing Editors: allocate applications to Editors & decide on inclusion or rejection

Quality Control

The journal must exercise peer-review or editorial quality control to be included.

Research Journal

Journals that report primary results of research or overviews of research results to a scholarly community.

Periodical

A serial appearing, or intending to appear, indefinitely at regular intervals and with minimum 5 articles annually, each issue of which is numbered or dated consecutively and normally contains separate articles, book-reviews/stories, or other writings.

Selection Criteria

Coverage

Subject

all research subjects are covered

Types of Sources

Accessible URL and homepage with clear and easy to Navigate, papers in full text with unique URL and HTML/PDF. Not display rank.

Journal Administrator

academic, government, commercial, non-profit private sources are all acceptable.

Level

the target group for included journals should primarily be Researchers or practitioners.

Content

a substantive part of the journal should consist of research papers. **All content should be available in full text.**

Language

All languages

- All content freely available.
 - A charge for the print version of a journal is permitted and Must be stated in the journal

Registration: **Free** user registration online is acceptable.

Require User to register to read content is not acceptable

Open Access without delay (no embargo period).

Through a peer-review system.

Listed editor, editorial board(5 person) with different affiliations.

At least two members have a PhD or equivalent for student body re-run Journal.

- The proportion of published papers where at least one of the authors is an editor, editorial board member or reviewer must not exceed 20% based on the research content of the latest two issues.

The journal should have an ISSN (International Standard Serial Number). The ISSN(s) must be displayed on the website

Journal name displayed on the website and application Match with issn.org

- The licensing terms for use and re-use of the published content must be clearly stated on the website and recommended embed in its article and use [Creative commons Licensing](#) .

The Copyrights must not contradict licensing term and Open Access terms. “All rights reserved” is never appropriate for open access content

- Copyrights must be clearly stated, applied to its content and separately from its Journal Website Copyrights.

Journal will be catalogued on journal title level

Journal should supply article metadata when a journal has been added into the directory to make article level content searchable in the system.
