

### Korean Council of Science Editors



- July 14: First meeting, supported by the Federation of Korean Science and Technology Organizations
- Sep 21: Founding of KCSE Dr. Jung-Il Jin
- Three editorial workshops
- Newsletter started: twice/year
- Joined the European Association of Scientific Journal Editors (EASE) & the Association of Learned and Professional Society Publishers (ALPSP)







- Joined the Council of Scientific Editors (CSE) & Crossref
- Educational workshops, forums, Scopus meeting for editors and manuscript editors of domestic scientific journals
- 1<sup>st</sup> International conference
- Science Editing inauguration (Korean)
- Newsletter: 4 times/year
- KCSE became a model for the development of scientific journals in Korea: 164 member societies and institutions and 105 group members
